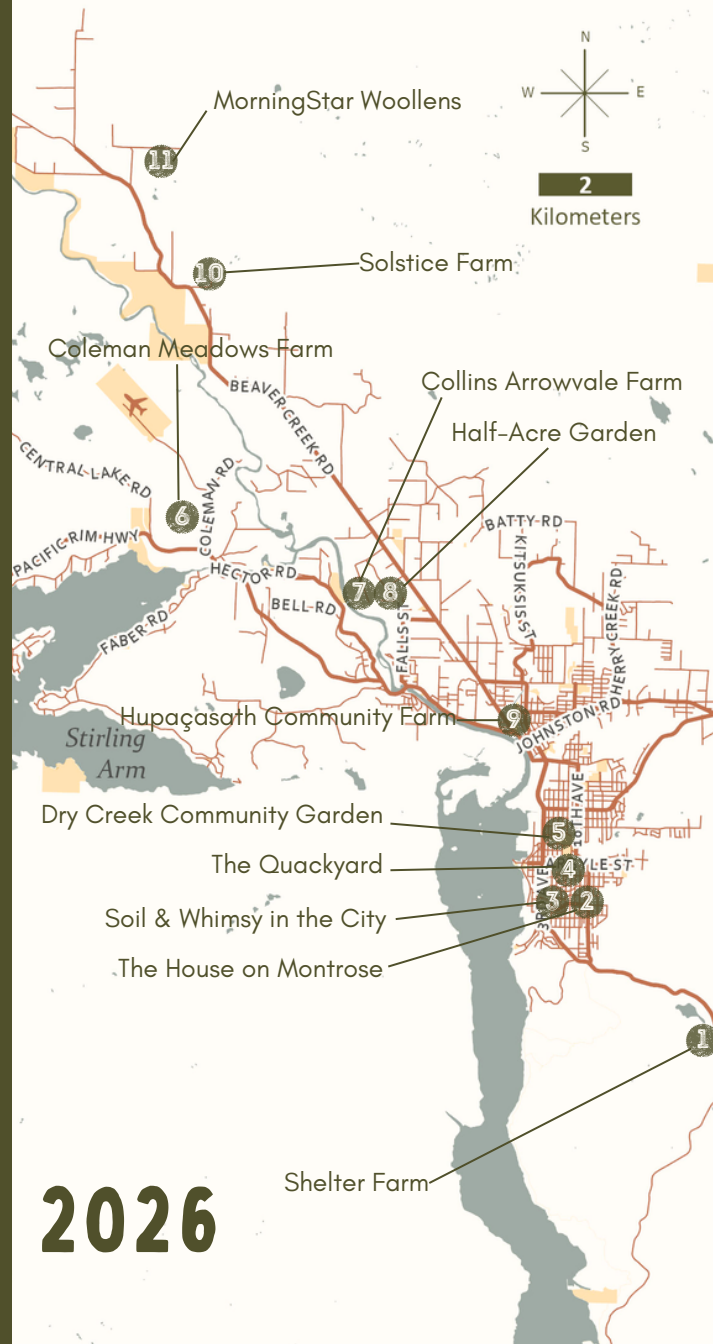

Solstice Farm is a welcoming, family-run operation nestled at the base of the Beaufort Mountains. The property features a growing apple orchard, vibrant cut flower gardens, seasonal produce, and friendly farm animals.

MORNING STAR WOOLLENS

9010 BRYSON ROAD

MorningStar Woollens combines creativity and sustainability driven by a "soil to stitch to stem". The farm raises Bluefaced Leicester sheep for high-quality textile fibres and also cultivates regenerative flowers used for arrangements and natural dyeing.
